

Case Report For July 2019

1. Shoplifting: Retail theft continues to affect our city. 27 calls for shoplifting during the month of July. Several were arrested and in possession of narcotics. Most property was turned back over to the retail stores.
2. 33 traffic collisions occurred in the city limits during the month of July.




