## MEMORADUM

**DATE:** February 6, 2020

**SUBJECT:** Little Texas Rd. and Benton Rd. Intersection Improvement

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City staff and SCDOT District Engineering office have developed a preliminary plan to address safety concerns at this intersection. District Engineers are proposing a roundabout to improve safety and congestion. Total project costs for the proposed roundabout is 40k. The SCDOT will perform all necessary work and contribute 25k toward the project. They have requested that the city contribute 15k towards asphalt.

Without objection I will move forward and pay for this project out of the Street Improvement Fund.

Next Steps - The SCDOT and City Staff will host a community meeting to present the roundabout design and receive community feedback. The SCDOT will also meet with individual property owners directly impacted by the project. Early indications are that this project can begin in spring of 2020.

**SUBJECT:** State Road Turn Back Request

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The SCDOT has initiated a “turn back” program that will compensate cities for taking over ownership of state roads within their jurisdiction. Cities are encouraged to submit a complete listing of all roads they wish to be considered. Compensation for roads is based on a set formula as follows:

**2-lane secondary road**

- Good Condition – one-time payment of \$561k/mile
- Bad Condition - Two options
  - Bring up to good condition & pay the one-time payment or
  - Pay 848k/mile

Attached is a list of state roads within the City that I recommend we submit for consideration. This request is for approximately 13 miles of two-lane secondary roads. This would be a total 7.3M request after all roads are brought up to good condition by SCDOT. This program is very competitive, and state funding is limited. Therefore, I do not anticipate all roads requested will be selected.

## Public Works Summary for January 2020

- **Sanitation:** Still Tracking complaints on ACE. We had 5 complaints last month trash and brush not picked up. A total of 10 recycle bins were delivered to residents. A total of 50 bags of litter was picked up in the month of January by 5 volunteers.
- **Road and Bridge:** January we had 7 complaints. Pothole on N Poinsett Hwy and a pothole on Hwy 25 N that were reported to SCDOT. City repaired three street signs and removed a tree from Batson Rd. 2 Encroachment Permit were issued. The City had a wayfinding sign struck by a vehicle did not stop. This has been filed with the Insurance company.
- **Animal Control:** 5 complaints were reported with 4 impoundments and 3 transported to Greenville Animal Care and 1 returned to owner. 3 traps were set for cats 205 Poplar St., 7 Willis St. and 15 McElhaney Rd
- **Sewer:** 3 inspections were performed. 2 sewer evaluations were conducted on lots in the city. Two complaints about a sewer related problem was reported and resolved by the city. Sewer main repair work on Benson St. REWA repaired this break. We are looking into sewer rehab work to be done on sewer main between Poinsett Hwy and Center Street.
- **Environmental:** A second letter was sent to Ingles Inc. in reference to the trash and construction material located in the rear of the building. One letter was sent to 101 Love Dr in reference to large number of cats at this location.
- **Building / Grounds Maintenance:** working with the Police Department to install Safe Transaction signs at City Hall. Leak at City Hall building was found and repaired by an outside plumber. Also, the Back-Flow preventer was repaired at City Hall.

### **Miscellaneous Items**

- **Christmas decorations were removed from Main St., Trailblazer Park, and City Hall with some lighting left up until March.**
- **The gate on the dumpster at Trailblazer Park was repaired.**
- **Back Flow preventer was repaired at City Hall.**
- **Street light at 117 Loraine Dr. was reported and repaired by Duke Energy.**
- **Trash cans and recycle containers are in and will be installed within a week are two.**
- **Safety Program I am working to improve the safety program already in place. We will be performing monthly training.**
- **Storm Update: Public Works along with the Police Department and Fire Department closed off 5 roads that were flooded. No other major damage was reported during the storm.**







- Curbside trash pickup to be served by The City of Travelers Rest.








OUTDOOR SEATING AREA








