REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
August 19, 2021 6:00 P.M.**

The following members were present: Brandy Amidon, Mayor, Harvey Choplin, Mayor Pro Tempore, Grant Bumgarner, Rick Floyd, Kelly Byers, Brantly Vest, Shaniece Criss, and Sara Gilstrap. Also, present were: Eric Vinson, City Administrator, Lori Sondov, City Clerk, Phillip Tate, PW Director, Ben Ford, Police Chief, Greg Robertson, Fire Chief, and Brennan Williams, Planning Director. The media were notified. There were seven members of the public who attended. Absent: Jeff George.

A. CALL TO ORDER AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

1. Mayor Amidon called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.
2. Council and staff recited the Pledge of Allegiance

C. APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

1. Councilmember Bumgarner made a motion to approve the minutes for the Regular Council Meeting held on July 15, 2021. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Floyd and carried unanimously.

E. CITIZEN PARTICIPATION (5-minute max)

1. Matt Gilstrap, 9 Lipscomb Street, spoke on public safety with regards to several issues, including crosswalks and the Swamp Rabbit Trail. Mr. Gilstrap presented a list of petitions, which can be found attached to these minutes.

F. ORDINANCE FOR SECOND READING

1. Councilmember Criss made the motion to consider Ordinance O-19-21 to rezone approximately 2.15 acres of real property located at 208 North Poinsett Highway and listed as Tax Map Number 0497000500300) (TR 21-10) from S-1, Services District, to R-M Residential, Multifamily District. This rezoning was recommended by the Planning Commission and Staff. Councilmember Bumgarner made the second.

Graham Mullikin addressed Council on behalf of the developer and stated there are no firm development plans for the property at this time. Mr. Mullikin stated the developer wants to work with the City to create a good site plan.

Planning Director Williams confirmed there are no tenants on the property being rezoned. Councilmembers discussed their concerns over potential development on the property without passing the rezoning. Councilmember Choplin referred to a letter from the property owner to offer reassurance of a longer timeline if the mobile home residents living on the adjacent property were displaced and stated he is still concerned about gentrification. Mayor Amidon expressed appreciation for the transparency of the developer and asked for Mr. Mullikin to share Council's interest in affordable housing to with the owner.

The motion passed 7-1 with Councilmember Choplin opposed.

3. An application is being presented to the C-Fund Committee to ask for half of the \$4.2 million Poinsett Project.
4. An air conditioning unit went out in the Old City Hall and Public Works Director Tate had it replaced.
5. The City has received the picnic tables it purchased through a grant. The Public Works team will be installing these in several areas throughout the City, including Trailblazer Park and near the History Museum.
6. A free mini-library will be installed in the upcoming week in Trailblazer Park.

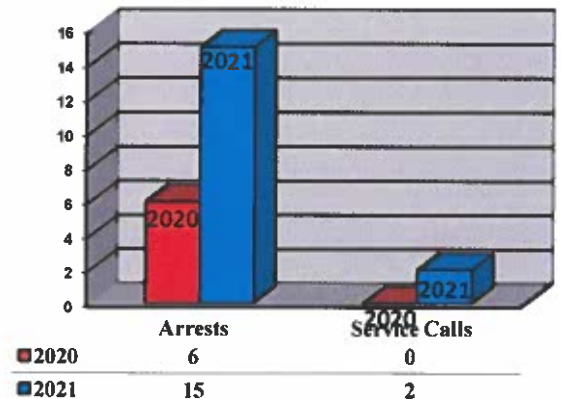

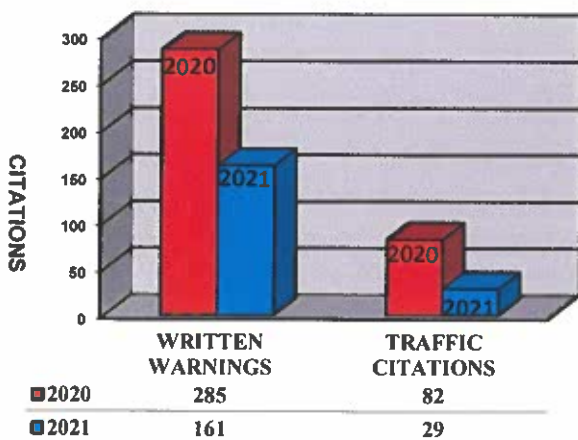

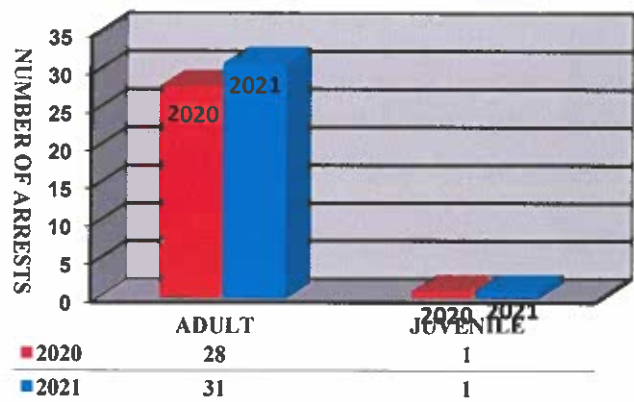
