

What you need to know about campaign signage...

Please read the requirements below to aviod having your signage removed. The city actively patrols and removes campaign signage that does not meet the guidelines.

DATES TO REMEMBER:

- *Installation*: no earlier than **60 days prior** to the election or referendum.
- **Removal:** no later than **5 days after** the election or referendum to which they apply.
- **Runoffs:** signs for candidates in a runoff election may be maintained until the final election and must be removed no later then **5 days after** the final election.

PLACEMENT:

- **DO**: place signs on private property with permission of the property owner.
- **DO NOT**: place signs on public property or public rights-of-ways. A right-of-way includes areas between sidewalks and the street, or between utility poles.
- **DO NOT:** place signage within 200 feet of the entrance to a polling place.
- DO NOT: fasten signage to trees or utility poles located in a public right-of-way or other public property.

NON-COMPLIANT SIGNAGE:

 Any sign not meeting these requirements will be removed by the City of Travelers Rest right-of-way crews, code enforcement officers and/or zoning officials.

IF YOUR SIGNAGE IS REMOVED: we will hold it for **7 days** before we dispose of it. **You will NOT be notified** if your signs are removed. It is the candidates responsibility to maintain their signage and to claim it within the 7 day period.
